What You Need to Apply:

- Government issued photo identification
- Proof of residence(lease, rent book, mortgage statement)
- Copies of Social Security Cards for all household members including children
- Proof of all your household's total gross income for the last 30 days (from all sources of income)
- The name of your home energy supplier and account number
- A copy of your most recent utility bill
