Sec. 27-464.08. - Medical Cannabis Uses—Dispensary.

- (a) The boundaries of property used as a medical cannabis dispensary shall be at least [500] 300 feet from:
 - (1) any R-A, R-E, R-L, R-R, R-S, R-80, or R-55 Zone;
- (2) any land owned by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission; and
 - (3) any school land uses.
- (b) A medical cannabis dispensary shall be located within 500 feet of a medical facility, as specified in Section 27-107.01 of this Subtitle.
- (c) Parking requirements for a medical cannabis dispensary shall be at least equivalent to the minimum parking requirements applicable to a medical practitioner's office/medical clinic, as set forth in Part 11 of this Subtitle.
 - (d) A medical cannabis dispensary shall not be permitted as an accessory use.
- (e) The boundaries of property used as a medical cannabis dispensary shall be at least one mile from any other medical cannabis dispensary use.
